

## INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAM/DISTRIBUTED LEARNING

Policy F.1.J

Independent study allows students the opportunity to take courses outside the regular classroom where a particular course may be unavailable or may not fit into their timetable. Students may take courses through Manitoba Education Distance Learning department including Independent Study Option, web based courses (WEB CT), and Teacher Mediated Option (TMO).

Frontier School Division will provide financial support to students in accordance with the attached regulations.

## INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAM/DISTRIBUTED LEARNING

Regulation F.1.J-R

## 1. Financial Support

When the following conditions are met, the Division shall finance courses taken with the Distance Learning department of Manitoba Education:

- a. The student is a resident of Frontier School Division.
- b. The student is attending a Division school.
- c. The school does not offer the course(s) the student wishes to take.
- d. The student pays the course fees and all costs associated with textbooks and supplies. Upon successful completion of the course, the Division shall reimburse the student for the course fees only.
