

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION – FOUR COLDEST MONTHS

Policy G.3.B

To ensure student safety during the four coldest months of the year, the Division will make provision for daily transportation for students who live between 0.8 kilometres and 1.6 kilometres from the school and who are not normally transported.

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION – FOUR COLDEST MONTHS

Regulation G.3.B-R

1. Eligibility

- a. Students are eligible for transportation during the four coldest months if they live between 0.8 kilometres and 1.6 kilometres of the school and are between the ages of four to nine.
- b. If a student who lives between 0.8 kilometres and 1.6 kilometres of the school becomes ten years old before December 31, he/she is not eligible for transportation during the four coldest months.

2. Starting Dates

- a. The starting date for transportation during the four coldest months shall be determined by the school committee and the Principal.
- b. The Principal shall notify the Transportation Coordinator of the date on which they would like transportation service to commence.

3. Approvals

a. All new requests for transportation services during the four coldest months or any requests for changes in existing service must have the approval of the Secretary-Treasurer.
