STRATEGIC PLAN DIALOGUE

The Board discussed and reflected upon their meeting with senior administration that took place on October 19-20, 2023. Discussions will continue on topics that arose during that meeting.

A program report on Academics: Literacy was provided by the Assistant Superintendent.

Discussion regarding Strategic Plan focus area: Indigenous Way of Life took place relative to language programming, and history books / local histories.

2022/23 AUDIT

The Board approved the audited financial statements for the year ended June 30, 2023. The Division's auditing firm reported no irregularities regarding the Division's accounts.

The Board approved the use of Division surplus by transferring funds to the capital reserve account for Divisional housing. Support for Engaged Learners Program, replacement of Cranberry Portage Elementary gymnasium floor, and replacement of ageing Technology infrastructure (computer servers) from surplus was also approved.

MEETING PLANNING

The Board discussed plans to meet with the Manitoba School Boards Association scheduled for December 14, and for meeting with the Deputy Minister of Education and Advanced Learning scheduled for December 15.

ANNUAL SCHOOL COMMITTEE CONFERENCE 2024
