STRATEGIC PLAN DIALOGUE

The Board continued discussions that arose in November regarding their meeting with senior administration in October; the November 1, 2023, Professional Development activity for all staff, and Indigenous Way of Life programming. The Board participated in a virtual Celebration Activity with Schools involved in the Educational Prosperity Program and The Learning Bar. Success stories were shared on literacy programming to support students learning to read.

MEETING WITH THE MANITOBA SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION

The Board met with the President and the Executive Director of the Manitoba School Boards Association and shared concerns regarding housing, recruitment and insurance programming effecting curricular objectives identified in the Indigenous Way of Life teachings. An invitation to visit Divisional schools was shared with the President and the Executive.

The Board discussed plans to meet with Minister Altomare and Deputy Minister O'Leary scheduled for January 18, 2024.

APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR

The Board approved a recommendation from the Finance Committee and appointed the auditing firm of Deloitte as Division Auditor for 2023-24. As outlined in *The Public Schools Act*, the Minister of Education will be notified of this appointment.

ANNUAL SCHOOL COMMITTEE CONFERENCE 2024

The Board continued discussion regarding their 2024 annual conference as plans for the event begin to take shape. Reports from administration will continue in the new year.

- Information was shared regarding the January 19, 2024, Professional Development activity for All Teachers with Trustees considering attendance at that activity.
- Information was shared regarding the 50th Anniversary of the Frontier Games Divisionals to be held in Area 5.
- Area 4 Vice-Chairperson Pearson provided a report on her attendance at the Frontier Area Games held in Cormorant, and the Frontier Collegiate holiday concert.
