PRESENTATIONS

The Board was presented with a framed painting from an Indigenous artist from Norway House to commemorate the Frontier Games 50th Anniversary. An additional framed photograph will be presented to Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning Minister Altomare in support of our Frontier Games.

In addition, administration unveiled the recently completed frame to house the Kokum (grandmother) Mask that was presented to the Board at their February meeting.

BOARD and SENIOR ADMINISTRATION MEETING

2024/25 BUDGET
