The hourly rate for casual Bus Drivers differs by Area.

Qualifications:

- Must have a good driving record
- Must submit a clear Criminal Record Check (including Vulnerable Sector Search) and Child Abuse Registry Check

TRAINING OFFERED CONSISTS OF:

- · 24 hours of training that will focus on:
- general school bus knowledge
- instruction for performing a pre-trip inspection
- in-vehicle and behind-the-wheel instruction
- · MPI Tests at an MPI Service Centre:
- written Class 2 knowledge test
- written school bus knowledge test
- pre-trip inspection test
- school bus road test

Upon successful completion of the training program you will receive a Class 2F driver's licence from MPI and a School Bus Operator's Certificate.
