



**HOME PLACEMENT PROGRAM
SECOND SEMESTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE
FRIDAY, JANUARY 17, 2025**

The deadline for second semester registration is **Friday, January 17, 2025**. Contact your local school principal or counsellor for the application forms. Please submit your completed application forms to the Governance Support Officer in your area before the deadline.

The following criteria determine a student’s eligibility for admission:

1. Regular Placement – The grade level is not available in the local school or daily transportation to a nearby school is not available.

- Parents/legal guardians of students must be current residents of Frontier School Division.
- Provincially funded students or treaty students living off-reserve are eligible for home placement.
- Recent school history (attendance, number of credits achieved, and previous school and home placement record) is reviewed.

2. Special Placement – A program of studies (technical-vocational) is not available in the local community or by daily transportation.

- Students must take 8 to 14 credits in this specialized field.
- In communities with high schools, Frontier School Division will fund students who enter the program in Grade 11.
- Exceptions shall be made for programs that require students to meet Level 1 apprenticeship requirements and students may apply in their Grade 10 year.

Parents/legal guardians must submit in writing a letter to the area superintendent requesting home placement for their child for a special program. Also, letters of support from the superintendent, principal and school committee must be received in advance.
